

Media Safety Rules

- 1. Presence at any venue of the event under the influence of alcohol, narcotics or other substances is strictly prohibited!
- 2. The accredited media representatives shall observe all the instructions of the stewards, safety personnel, and official persons of the event at all times.
- 3. When at special stage, the accredited media representatives shall observe all the markings and respect the surroundings. If it is a NO-GO area, it is a NO-GO area for media as well.
- 4. When at special stage, choose location that is as safe as possible. Be prepared to unusual situations or accidents during the event at all times! If you are near to the track, follow racing activity at all times.
- 5. The accredited media representative with the media tabard issued by the organiser of the event is entitled to be present in the especially envisaged media zones or outside the spectators' areas, as per given instructions and guidelines of the organiser.
- 6. The accredited media representative without the media tabard issued by the organiser of the event is not entitled to be present in the especially envisaged media zone or outside the spectators' areas.
- 7. Presence and operations of the accredited media representatives and their equipment at any venue of the event in no way can alter safe running of the event and / or result set by the competitors.
- 8. The accredited media representatives are forbidden to use drones or any other ground-controlled flying device.
- 9. Beware of moving racing vehicles! Motorsports can be dangerous and your safety at any venue of the event depends only on you. Pay close attention to the surrounding activities!
- 10. Avoid being too close to racing vehicles. When at service park, do not disturb work of the mechanics around the cars! Do not disturb work of the teams!
- 11. Do not recline against the racing vehicles as they may start sudden movement and some car parts may be fragile and/ or hot.
- 12. Avoid standing nearby fire-fighting, ambulance and / or steward vehicles as they may start sudden movement without prior warning.
- 13. When reviewing the working material (photos, videos, etc.), avoid doing it in close proximity to the special stage. Choose a safer place!
- 14. Avoid crossing the special stage as much as possible. If you need to cross, do it in a place with good visibility and make sure no racing vehicle is approaching.
- 15. Breach of any of the media safety rules may be a reason for annulment of accreditation and banning from the event.
- 16. By submitting the media accreditation application, you confirm that you have read the media accreditation rules and media safety rules, agree with them, and take full responsibility for your actions.
