



## Media Safety Rules

1. Presence at the race venue under the influence of alcohol, narcotics or other substances is strictly prohibited!
2. The accredited media representatives shall observe all the instructions of the stewards, safety personnel, and official persons of the rally at all times.
3. When at special stage, the accredited media representatives shall observe all the markings and be aware of the surroundings. If it is a NO-GO area, it is a NO-GO area for media as well.
4. Choose the location at the special stage, which is as safe as possible. Be prepared to unusual situations or accidents during the event at all times! If you are near to the special stage, follow race activity at all times.
5. The accredited media representative with the media tabard issued by the organiser of the rally is entitled to be present in the especially envisaged media zones and outside spectator zones, as per given instructions of the organiser.
6. The accredited media representative without the media tabard issued by the organiser of the rally is entitled to be present in the spectator zones only.
7. Presence of the accredited media representatives and their equipment at the race venue, as well as working result of the both in no way can alter safe running of the race or result set by the competitors.
8. Accredited media representatives are forbidden to use drones or any other ground-controlled flying device.
9. Beware of moving vehicles! Your safety at the track or service park depends only on you. Pay close attention to the surrounding activities!
10. Avoid being too close to the rally cars at the service park! Do not disturb work of the mechanics around the cars! Do not disturb work of teams!
11. Avoid reclining against the rally cars as they may start sudden movement and some car parts may be fragile and/ or hot.
12. Avoid standing nearby fire-fighting, steward and/ or ambulance cars as they may start sudden movement without prior warning.
13. In case it is necessary to review the working material (photos, videos, etc.), avoid doing it near the special stage. Choose a safe place!
14. Avoid crossing the special stage as much as possible. If you need to cross the special stage, do it in a place with good visibility and make sure no rally car is approaching. Even though rally cars start in intervals, always make sure that no car is approaching, even if the previous competitor has just passed by.
15. **Breach of any of the media safety rules may be reason for annulment of accreditation and expulsion from the race.**
16. **By submitting the media accreditation application, you confirm that you have read the media accreditation rules and media safety rules, agree with the above, and take full responsibility for your actions.**
